Addendum #3 – Elementary Pupil Free Day

September 24, 2020

The **Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School District** (“District”) and the **Santa Monica-Malibu Classroom Teachers Association** (“Association”), collectively referred to as “the Parties,” entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) regarding the reopening of schools for the 2020 - 2021 school year in light of the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. The MOU was signed by the Parties on August 7, 2020.

On Thursday, September 24, 2020, the District and SMMCTA met for continued negotiations regarding the existing reopening MOU. During the discussion the option was raised to adjust the calendar moving the elementary pupil free day from November 3 to November 5.

The Parties agree that the calendar shall be changed as follows:

November 4 – Minimum Day, Teacher Conferences

November 5 – Minimum Day, Teacher Conferences
