

## February 11, 2021 Bargaining update.

Today we worked for six (6) plus hours to bargain the parameters around the reopening of schools in the Distance Learning “+” model.

Here are 7 take-aways:

- Our discussion centered around a return to in-person learning that will be safe for the entire community.
- The District is working on a plan with St. John’s/Providence to get all members vaccinated once vaccines are available. (We believe that access to vaccines is an important component of a return to in-person learning.)
- We remain committed to the requirements articulated in LA County DPH protocols. Please understand that LA County guidance on when it is safe to reopen for various grade levels may shift in the coming days and weeks.
- We are committed to protecting Distance Learning as our primary model for delivering instruction.
- While SLT/FAC determine the student experience of “plus”, our team is bargaining the member expectations for DL+.
- More child-care hubs are opening to accommodate staff member’s children.
- We continue to consider of all members and families in making sure students who do not participate in DL+ will have alternative activities.

We will meet with the district tomorrow, Friday, February 12th, at 2:30, to continue bargaining.
