

Draft of Proposed Timeline for Chapter Elections 2021

February 22, 2021 (Monday)

- Announcement of vacancy of Middle School EB Member for the remainder of the 2021 term (April, May, June).
- Announcement of all seats for the 2021-2021 Executive Board Term.
- Vacancy announcements will be posted on our website and padlet, as will nomination forms.

March 16th, 2021 (Tuesday)

- Declaration of Candidacy to fulfill the remaining term of the EB Middle School Seat with Candidate statement due. This candidate statement will be shared with all site reps prior to the election.

March 22, 2021 (Monday, Rep Council Meeting)

- Rep Council Votes on Middle School EB member for remainder of 2021 Term only.
- Update/reminder to all site reps that there will be an election for the full terms of the Eboard.

March 26th, 2021 (Friday)

- All candidate declarations and statements must be turned in.

March 27th – April 19th, 2021

- Candidate Statements will be posted to the website
- Correct voter information and eligibility will be verified and added to Simply Voting. If multiple candidates run for the same position, they will be listed according the current CTA alphabet.
- Information about all of the candidates running, in collaboration with the candidates, will be sent to all current SMMCTA members. Proofs will be available.

April 26th, 2021 (Site Rep Meeting)

- All candidates running will be give two minutes to speak about their candidacy.
- Information about all the candidates will be sent to all current SMMCTA members eligible to vote.

April 27th – May 16th, 2021

- Voting shall take place online.
- The vote will close on May 16th, at 11:59 pm.

May 17, 2021

- The votes will be electronically counted.
- Election results will be shared with the Eboard via email in advance of their regular meeting.
- Election results will be shared with the candidates.
- After the Eboard meeting election results will be posted online.

SMMCTA has chosen Simply Voting to conduct our election.

Emails will go out to all current members with a unique url allowing them to vote in the election.
