

SAMPLE MIDDLE SCHOOL DISTANCE LEARNING SCHEDULE

Teacher Communication: Teachers will provide families with a weekly learning plan, updates, specific learning outcomes, and activities for students. Students will have daily live instruction.

Time Expectations: Students must receive a minimum of 240 minutes of instruction daily. Teachers will provide synchronous and/or asynchronous lessons/activities throughout the week.

For Teaching Periods:	<p>On Mondays, teachers will facilitate live interaction for the duration of the period in a compressed schedule and assign asynchronous work to a total 240 instructional minutes. Students are responsible for completing all asynchronous work.</p> <p>Tuesday through Friday, teachers will offer interactive lessons/activities including, but not limited to: whole group / small group instruction, SEL activities, informal / formal assessment, academic support. Students should plan to complete work during this time. Unfinished work should be completed independently at the end of the school day.</p>
